This Month's Take 5 Safety Message: "Angle Grinder Safety"

This **Take-5** covers angle grinder safety. Angle grinder discs can rotate at speeds between 5,000 to 12,000 rotations per minute. The most common causes of angle grinder injuries include lacerations from angle grinder kickbacks and projectiles from broken attachments.
